**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALSACE, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-4, ENTITLED, AN
ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ALSACE, COUNTY OF BERKS,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA PROVIDING FOR THE
REGULATION OF THE INSTALLATION OF NEW ON-LOT WELLS ON
PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF ALSACE**


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Alsace Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania previously adopted Alsace Township Ordinance No. 2005-4 and now finds it desirable to revise and amend Ordinance 2005-4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is Enacted and Ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of Alsace Township, that Ordinance 2005-4, Alsace Township Well Ordinance, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 2, Specifications, subsection 1.c. is amended as follows:
"For lots served by public sewer, side lot lines, rear lot lines and front lot lines which do not abut or lie within a road (as defined by the Alsace Township Zoning Ordinance) – 10 feet. For lots served by on-lot sewage disposal, side lot lines, rear lot lines and front lot lines which do not abut or lie within a road (as defined by the Alsace Township Zoning Ordinance) - 25 feet."
2. Section 2, Specifications, subsection 1.d. is amended as follows:
"Centerline of a road – 35 feet."
3. All other provisions and sections of Ordinance 2005-4 of the Township of Alsace, Berks County, Pennsylvania, are hereby reaffirmed and restated in their entirety.
4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as same affects this Ordinance.
5. Should any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and shall remain in full force and effect.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment.


