An inspection must be made by the Sewage Enforcement Officer (SEO) to verify the well location prior to drilling.

The "Certificate of Well Construction" attached to this form and a copy of the well driller's log must be completed by the well driller and returned to the Township no later than 14 days after the well is completed. The property owner must have the water from the new well tested at a laboratory for total fecal coliform bacteria content, and submit the results to the Township within 14 days of the completion of the well.

The Alsace Township Well Ordinances 2005-04 and 2020-01 require the following:

“For lots served by public sewer, side lot lines, rear lot lines and front lot lines which do not abut or lie within a road (as defined by the Alsace Township Zoning Ordinance) – 10 feet. For lots served by on-lot sewage disposal, side lot lines, rear lot lines and front lot lines which do not abut or lie within a road (as defined by the Alsace Township Zoning Ordinance) - 25 feet. All wells shall be at least 100 feet from any sewage absorption area. This ordinance also requires that all wells be constructed with well casing extended at least to bedrock depth. Plastic casing is not permitted. In addition, all wells must be grouted.
